

Basic SkyScreen Setup

- 1. Setup SkyScreens **5–10 feet** down range.
- 2. Place **cables on the ground** as much as possible.
- 3. Make sure the **cables are separate** from each other.
- Make sure the chronograph unit itself is NOT being hit by muzzle blast.
- 5. **Isolate the unit** from the shockwave.
- Make sure you are using a recently purchased, fully charged
 9V battery.
- 7. The BEST conditions are a **bright**, **overcast day**.
- On VERY bright blue-sky days, try canting the sensors over
 60 to 90 degrees either left or right. This will increase the contrast of the bullet to the background.
